

**POCATELLO FIELD ARCHERS
BOWHUNTER OF THE YEAR, GAME AWARDS,
& "BEST OF BIG GAME SPECIES" AWARD
2022 ENTRY FORM**

RULES:

1. Participants must complete one form for each animal they wish to enter. Please print legibly. A tasteful printed photo must accompany the entry. (See below)
2. **A participant must be a member of Pocatello Field Archers before the opening date of the entered species' archery season.**
3. The entered animal must be harvested in the State of Idaho, January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2022.
4. If the animal qualifies for Pope and Young, a bonus of one-half the male point value will be added to the score. An official Pope and Young score sheet must be turned in with this form.
5. If two animals of the same species are legally harvested within the same year, points will be given for the first animal only.
6. Small game will be counted as 5 points for each species taken.
7. **Deadline for ALL entries is March 1, 2023.** Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted.
8. Fair chase rules apply. Animals harvested on private hunting ranches or otherwise within "high fence" areas will not be accepted for these awards.
9. To be considered for Bowhunter of the Year, a member must accumulate a minimum of 50 points for the year.
